



PRESTACIÓN DE ASISTENCIA SANITARIA PROVIDING HEALTH ASSISTANCE

When making an application for *yourself or your dependents including husband's or partner's, expat residents who are on a limited income, brother or sister of the entitled person (paying social security), divorced or separated persons who are not being covered by their ex partners any more. The form you are obliged to fill in can be obtained from any department of the 'Seguridad Social' INSS. This form does not have a number and is headed: ASISTENCIA SANITARIA.

There are instructions in Spanish on how to complete the form and documents that must be presented.

The instructions state that, the form does not need to be completed by those covered for health care because they are self employed, employed or unemployed (when the unemployment benefit has been exhausted), pensioners and those covered with social security payments periodically. (This is in their database).

Expat pensioners **WILL** have to fill in a separate form.

The form must be filled out for those who do not have an income superior of 100.000 euro per annum, dependents of these persons and also used when changing from one covered person to another. Due to the complexity of the descriptions, it is best to make an appointment at your local INSS office and explain your needs.

A note for the two groups mentioned below.

Common law marriage, or partners. Provide a certificate of registration in the register of the relevant register in the autonomous region, place of residence or accreditation of the constitution of the couple by deed at the notary.

2. Those who are not working, without a pension and not able to pay for private insurance, need to apply as a 'persona sin recursos'

The SS demand that you apply for a form in your country of origin (in the UK this is provided in Spanish) that states that you are not in receipt of medical care in that country. This is applied for from the department of work and pensions in the UK.
